**MJR & Virtue Focus:** To begin the year, our Making Jesus Real focus is GTS. GTS stands for Greet, Treat and Speak. This focus is about how we Greet people - how we say hello and welcome them. GTS is about how we Treat other people - when we are happy with them, but even when we might be angry with them. And GTS is about how we speak to other people - remembering that what we say to people, and how we say it, can help them to have a good day or a bad day. GTS is linked to our Kindness Virtue. We think about Greeting people Kindly, Treating them Kindly and Speaking to them Kindly. Jesus came to be our model for how to treat others. He always Greeted people Kindly, Treated them Kindly and Spoke to them Kindly. This was the Second Great Commandment of Jesus: Love your neighbour as yourself. This means that we should treat other people as we would want them to treat us: with Kindness, Care and Compassion. So, for the next two weeks, as we focus on GTS, think about how you would like other people to Greet you; how you would like other people to Treat you; and how you would like other people to Speak to you.
